SEARCHING USING FILTERS

- You can manually type in the criteria you are looking for.
- You have the option of changing the "Field". In the example to the left, the word "Product" was searched.

LABEL & VALUE **FILTERS**

- You can choose "Label Filters" or "Value Filters" which will allow you to only select data with a certain criteria.
- For example, "Value Filter" is set to show the Sum of Units sold that are greater than 23,000.
